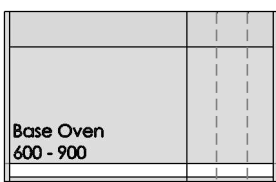


Use Corner Filler Sets between Pantry Blind Corner 2 Stacked Doors Cabinets and adjacent Base Cabinets.

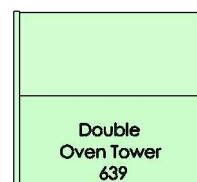

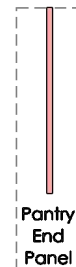
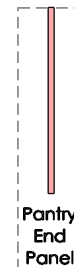
BASE OVEN CABINET
