Product Line Interior Cabinetry for Kitchens, Wardrobes, Laundry and other interior furniture situations

Product Description

The Cabinetry Range available in flexible size and a range of specific configurations depending on the situation and purpose, and customer requirements. It consists of a cabinet (carcass), matched with door, and panels attached to the cabinets.

The cabinets are constructed from low formaldehyde moisture resistant particle board or MDF board finished with a low pressure laminate (melamine), or PET Laminate on the doors. The board is sourced from New Zealand's sustainable FSC certified Radiata pine plantations. Edges are taped with colour matching edge tapes made of plastics (PVC, ABS, or PP) bonded with PUR bonding technology providing a heat resistant, moisture resistant and near seamless bond.

Relevant Building Code Clauses

- Durability: B2.3.1c (i)(ii) :- 5 Years durability if: The building elements (..including fixtures) are easy to access and replace, and (ii) Failure of those building elements to comply with the building code would be easily detected during normal use of the building
- Hazardous Building Materials F2.3.1 :- The quantities of gas, liquid, radiation or solid particles emitted by materials used in the construction of buildings, shall not give rise to harmful concentrations at the surface of the material where the material is exposed, or in the atmosphere of any space)

All materials used are inert at normal interior temperatures in New Zealand. There are no requirements for this product to comply with Acceptable Solution F2/AS1, First Edition Amendment 3, 2017

Scope of Use

- TDC Limited Cabinetry range to be used for internal installations only.
- They are suitable for use in Residential and Commercial applications

Conditions of Use

- Cabinets require walls and floors to be plumb and flat.
- While constructed from moisture resistant board it is recommended the room be well ventilated.
- Do not position the cabinetry in the direct path of any water, any spillages must be wiped up immediately
- Cabinets must be installed level and without any twist for doors and drawers to operate
- Cabinets must be attached to the walls using suitable hardware fixed into solid fixings such as studs or noggs
- When installed, it is recommended to seal the backs of cabinets and panels to walls.

Dimension, Plans and Specifications

- i) All customary building industry tolerances shall apply to the dimensions and measurements of Goods unless TDC Limited and the Purchaser agree otherwise in writing.

- iii) If the giving of an estimate or quotation for the supply of Goods involves TDC Limited estimating measurements and quantities, it shall be the responsibility of the Purchaser to verify the accuracy of such estimate before accepting such quotation.
- iv) Should the Purchaser require any changes to TDC Limited's estimated measurements and quantities, the Purchaser shall request such changes in writing, in the case of an estimate, before placing an order based on that estimate, and in the case of a quotation, before acceptance of that quotation.
- v) Where the Purchaser requests changes to be made to estimated quantities or measurements after TDC Limited has accepted the Purchaser's order in writing, the price shall be appropriately adjusted and any estimated delivery date rescheduled.

Manufacturing Guarantee and Care of Product

- vi) The Purchaser agrees and accepts that quoted sizes of all products are nominal, and that there will be some variation in dimension and size based on standard raw material and manufacturing variances or tolerances.
- vii) TDC Limited will guarantee the products supplied against faulty workmanship and faulty materials in line with standard industry expectations for each product up to a maximum of 5 years from the date of delivery. To exercise this guarantee the Purchaser must have documentary proof that the goods originated from the Supplier.
- viii) TDC Limited expressly does not guarantee the products against any other incident, occurrence or fault (including, without limitation, against normal household wear and tear, abuse and impact damage, exposure to heat or moisture, exposure to prolonged direct sunlight or humidity, surface damage from contact with abrasive or sharp items, or exposure to abrasive cleaners, liquids and incorrect handling by customers including incorrect assembly).
- ix) TDC Limited reserves the right to modify or change materials and components on individual items where it is considered necessary by the Supplier.
- x) For general care, note – it is recommended to wipe off spilt liquids immediately. General cleaning should be with a soft cloth.
